My Generous Gift!

In Mark 12 (41:44) The widow gave two small coins, but Jesus said she gave more than anyone else because she gave all she had.

Think about something *you* could give – not money, but something from your heart.

Generosity Freeze Frames

In small groups, children create a frozen picture (a "freeze frame") showing someone being generous. E.g., sharing lunch, helping a friend.

1. Think of 5-10 thoughtful actions - like helping with chores, giving hugs, or letting someone else choose a game.
2. Write each one on a separate paper coupon.

4. Give the coupon book (or separate tokens) to someone you care about, who can "redeem" the generous acts over time.
