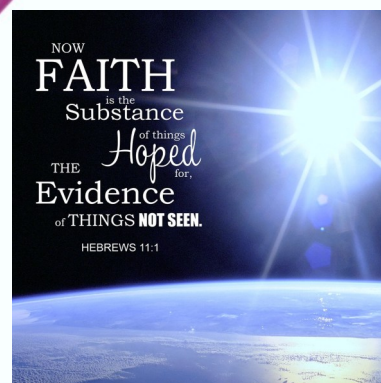

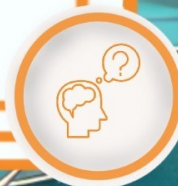

Prayer of the week

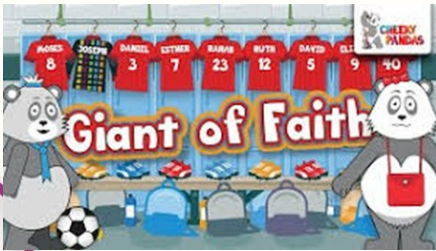
Dear God,
