Draw a **lightbulb** and write one wise choice you want to make this year (something that helps, not hurts).

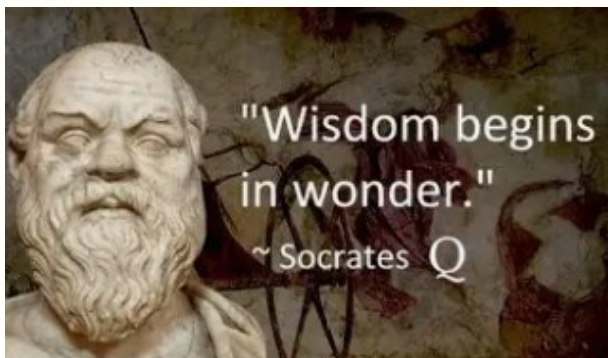


Then draw a **footprint** and write one small step you can take to put that wise choice into action.
