This week's activity

"My Courage Shield"



What to do:

Provide each child with a shield outline, or ask them to design and draw their own St George shield.

Ask them to divide it into four sections and draw or write:

1. A time I was brave
2. A way I can show kindness
3. A challenge I want to face
4. A word that gives me strength (e.g. courage, faith, kindness, hope)

Explore further at home



Create a Courage Pebble or Stone

- Go for a walk and choose a **small pebble or stone**.
- At home, paint or decorate it with:
 - A cross, heart, star, or simple symbol of courage or faith
 - A word such as *brave*, *hope*, or *kind*

Keep the stone in a pocket or special place as a reminder to be brave.

Talk with an adult: How can this stone remind you to make brave and kind choices, even when things feel hard?
