Starting School

Things your child will need to bring to school:

- A book bag, so books and homework can be sent home and kept clean and tidy
- A waterproof coat, for outdoor play
- Water bottle with fresh water in daily (NO JUICE)
- Spare socks/underwear
- A healthy packed lunch (if your child does not want to stay for a school dinner)

Milk

Your child will be provided with a carton of milk every morning break at a cost of £6.00 per year. In Key Stage 1 (Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2)

Healthy Snack

Your child will be provided with a healthy morning snack at a cost of £36.00 for the school year. Children will be provided with free fruit in an afternoon.

School Dinner

School meals are provided free of charge for Key Stage 1 (Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2). Please let the class teacher know when your child starts school if they would like to stay for a school meal.

School Absence

If your child is unwell please ring the school office on 01744 678400, email office@nutgrove.epworthtrust.org.uk or send a message through Parentapp (information enclosed) as to why your child is unwell before 9.30am. If your child has sickness/diarrhoea please keep them off school for 48 hours after the last episode.

Please refrain from making medical appointments in school time unless it is a hospital appointment or an emergency doctors/dentist appointment.

A copy of a medical appointment letter will need to be brought into school or sent via email, otherwise the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
