



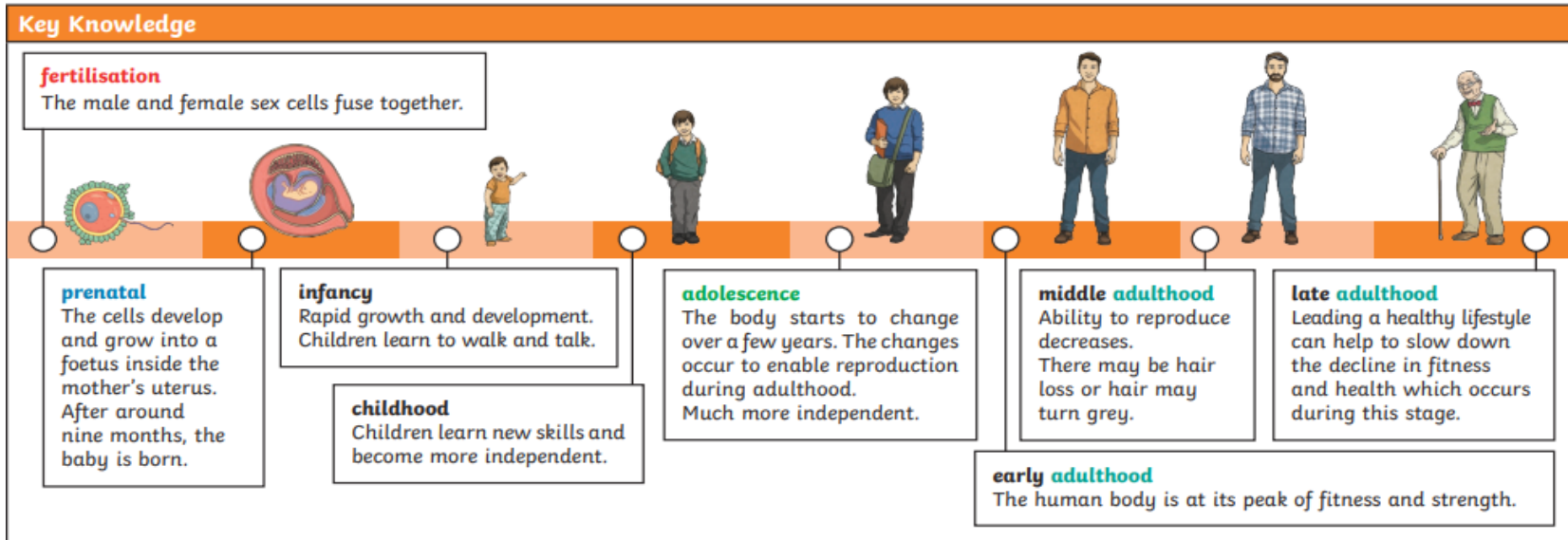
Sticky knowledge
